One of the goals of the Arboretum's "Vision 2010" is to

"Create educational programs in partnership with the regional community that will provide opportunities for environmental education."

The Education and Conservation (E&C) committee has the responsibility of designing and implementing programs that help meet this goal. Within that overall charter, specific responsibilities of the E&C committee include:

- Development of materials and enlistment of individuals to make educational presentations at general meetings, exhibits, fairs, garden clubs and other special events.
- Development of information and materials and enlistment of individuals to provide a docent program for the Arboretum.
- Overseeing the provision of educational programs in conjunction with individuals, school groups, or other organizations interested in learning about and enhancing their surroundings through the use of sound horticultural practices which promote environmental stewardship.
- Coordinating the collection, propagation, and cataloging of live and herbarium specimens.
- Development of an interpretive center for the Arboretum to house activities and services worthy of a nationally recognized institution.
