

# **SKCAF Lake Wilderness Arboretum Access and Use Policy**

## **General**

The Lake Wilderness Arboretum is for the use and enjoyment of the general public. It is open from dawn to dusk. All City of Maple Valley Park rules apply to the Lake Wilderness Arboretum.

## **Special Use**

Special use of the grounds is restricted to functions consistent with the atmosphere of the arboretum, such as garden concerts, flower shows, garden fairs, park programs, including seasonal lighting displays, plant sales, and docent-guided tours.

As the arboretum develops, areas may become available for private functions. It is the SKCAF board's responsibility to determine appropriateness of requests and to insure city permit requirements are met and scheduling conflicts are avoided. A fees structure for private functions will be determined by the SKCAF board.

## **Access to Nursery and Sheds**

Combinations to the nursery gate locks are released only to contractors needing access and well-established volunteers needing access.

Combinations to the shed locks are released only to the Property Manager, Nursery Manager and well-established volunteers needing access.
