Nature Paint Brush

Make your own nature paint brush using a stick and natural objects



Age:3+

Time: 30 minutes

Find materials for this activity in the Children's Discovery Forest.

Here's How:

- 1. Gather several sticks 10 12 inches long.
 - > These will be the handles of your paint brushes.
- **2. Gather many natural objects** you find on the ground, including feathers, leaves, grass, weeds, and moss.
- **3. Loop a rubber band several times on the end of each stick**, or wrap a few grasses around and around the stick.
- 4. Slide a natural object under the band or grass.
- 5. Make many paint brushes!
- **6.** At home, dip the brushes into water and paint the sidewalk, or into a paint pot and paint on paper.
 - Notice the different textures and patterns the nature objects make.

The Back Story

Painting experiences stimulate brains and allow children to express themselves in creative and open-ended ways. Handling nature brushes strengthens hands, wrists, and fingers; aids development of motor skills; and contributes to eye-hand coordination and sensory development.
